No blue jeans!

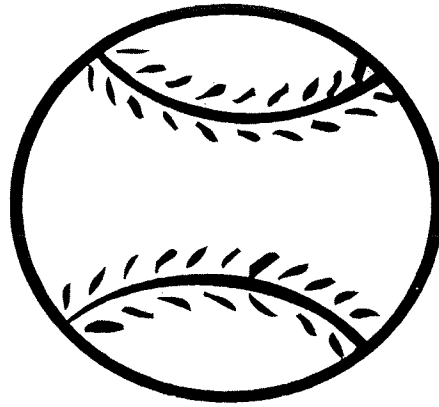

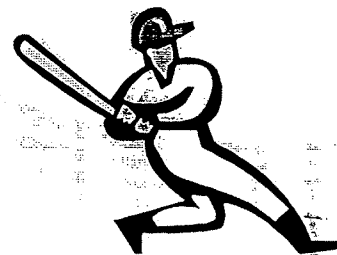

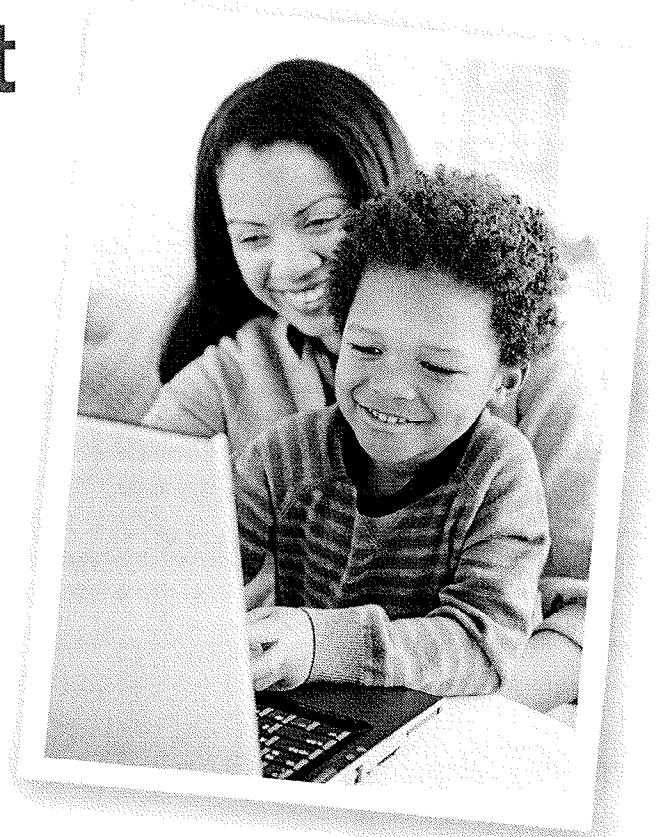
